

ELEC. RATE DECREASE

Effective for all bills issued as of April 1, 2015:
The "GTA" component on all SELCO electric bills will decrease to \$0.0033. As a result of this adjustment, the R-1 residential rate will drop approximately 8% from \$0.13116 /kWh to \$0.12016 /kwh.

FREE Tree Giveaway - SELCO will be giving away 750 free trees to Shrewsbury residents. All selected varieties are resistant to Asian Longhorn Beetle infestation, and are not classified as host trees.

Seedling quantities are limited - first come, first served. Trees will not be distributed before 8:30 a.m. Trees are available to SELCO customers only. Please bring a SELCO bill or other ID proving Shrewsbury residency. Available varieties include:

- **Tuliptree** Bright green leaves that resemble tulip flowers, golden yellow fall colors. Grows 70' to 90' with 40' spread.
- **River Birch** This fast growing tree has unique, peeling, cinnamon-colored bark. Year-round color standing out in the fall and winter. Grows 40' to 70' with a 40' to 60' spread.
- Washington Hawthorn This late blooming, flowering tree is the preferred tree for songbirds! It has great fall color: orange, scarlet or purple. Grows 25' to 30' with a 25' spread.
- **Eastern Redbud** Spectacular rosy pink blossoms that appear in April. Great colorful foliage year round with reddish-brown leaves changing to dark green then to yellow in fall. Grows to 20' to 30' with 25' to 35' spread.
- **Prairiefire Flowering Crabapple** This hardy tree capable of growing in a wide range of conditions. Bright red flowers and Showy Fall foliage make this tree perfect addition to any yard. Bird- and wildlife-friendly fruit. Short ornamental tree 15'–20' tall by 15' wide

BENEFITS OF A MUNICIPALLY OWNED UTILITY

In addition to the cash benefits to the Town highlighted below, each SELCO cable customer saved approximately \$100.00 in 2014 compared to what they would have paid Charter Cable for basic and expanded basic cable services (not including taxes and fees, which would make the savings even greater).
